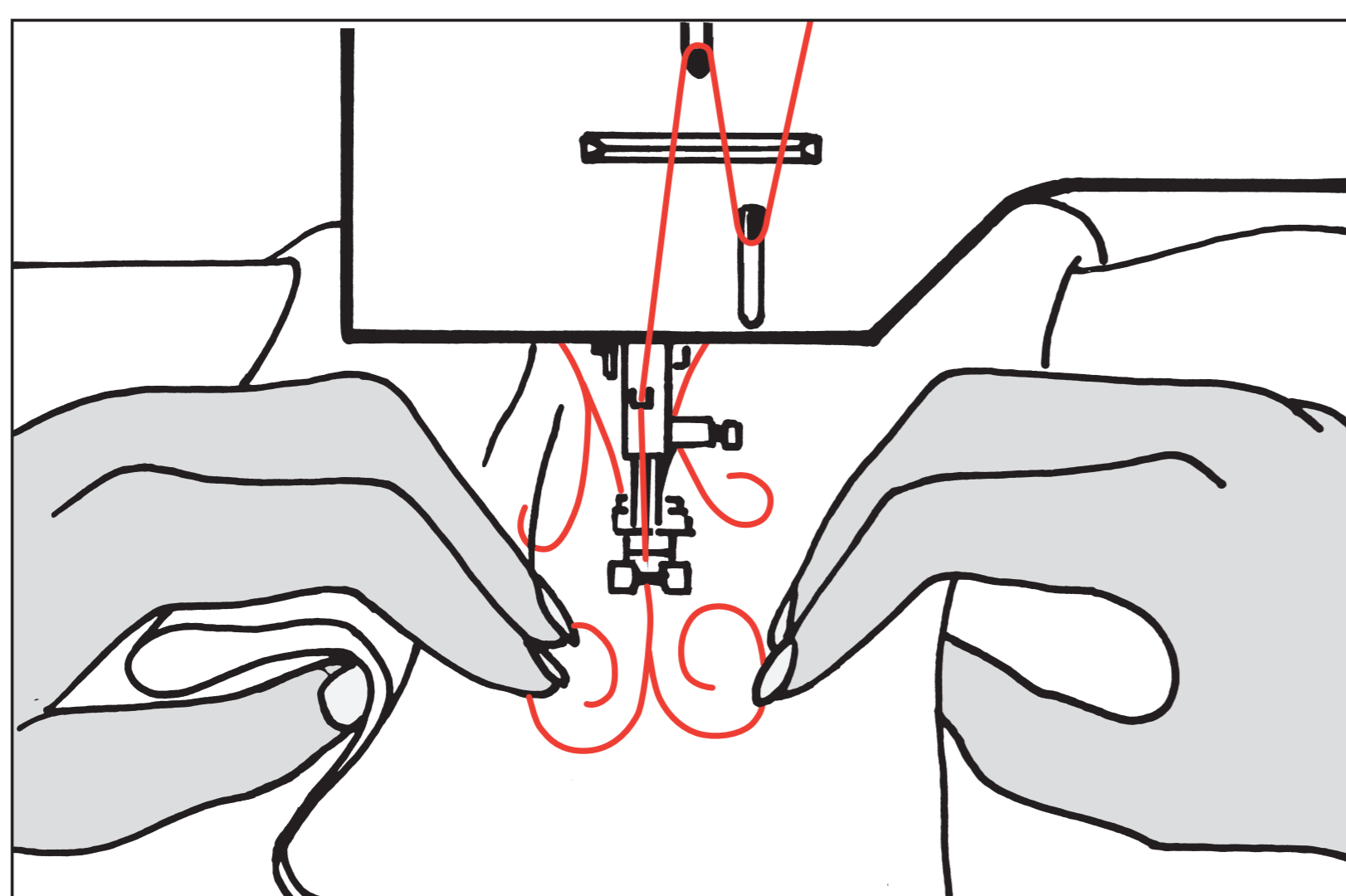
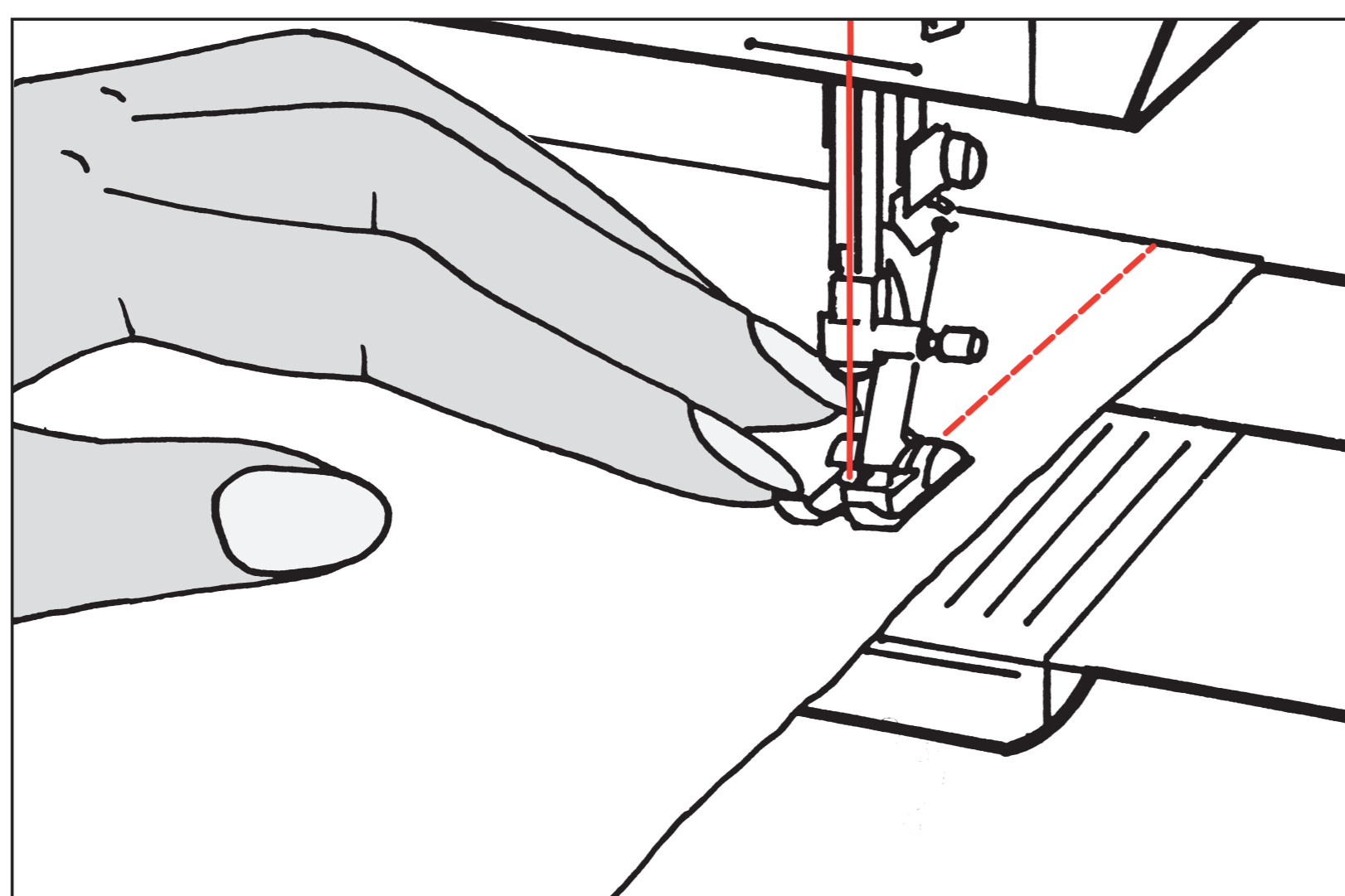
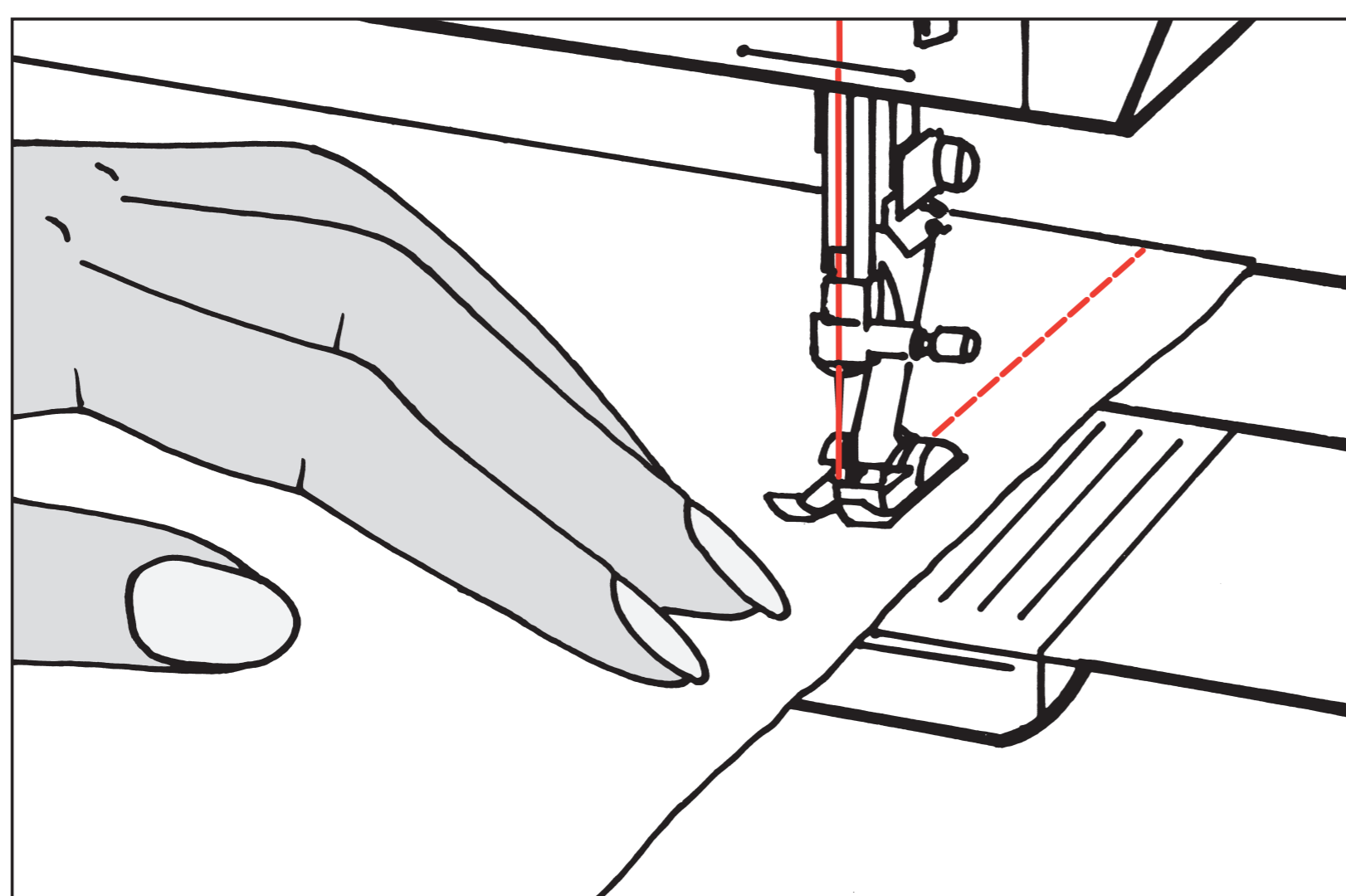


Correct guiding of the fabric

to ensure excellent sewing results



Instructions

Straight-stitching:

When using purely forward-fed stitches such as straight stitch, zigzag, etc.

Using your left hand, guide the project from the side on the stitching line close to the presser foot.

Reverse-fed stitches such as triple straight stitch, double overlock stitch, buttonholes, etc.:

With your left hand, guide the project at needle level close to the presser foot.

Free-motion and curve stitching:

Use both hands to guide the project, keeping your thumbs under the fabric. Large projects are folded on each side (see drawing). Guide the project close to the presser foot, stretching the fabric a little at the sides, but without applying pressure.

Sit comfortably when sewing!

Place the BERNINA sewing/embroidery computer far enough inside the table edge (approx. 10 cm) so that you can comfortably operate it. Attach the slide-on table. If possible, rest your left elbow on the table. Centre yourself in front of the needle, not in front of the machine.

Check that you're sitting at the right height – you must be able to view the stitching of the needle in the presser-foot opening!

A successful result depends to a great extent on the correct working position and guiding of the project.
